## Excursion in Duong Lam Ancient Village – Private (Full Day) code NVN - 03

### DESCRIPTION

"Duong Lam village in Son Tay Town (some 60km to the west of Hanoi Capital) is the first ancient village recognized as a national relic by the Ministry of Culture and Information.

The ancient village has a history of about 1,200 years with many houses dating back up to 400 years. One special thing about the village is that most of the buildings here are made of laterite and mud, two materials that are abundant in the area. Laterite is used on house walls, gates, wells, temple walls, and so forth. The mud is taken from ponds. Apart from its historical and tourism values, Duong Lam ancient village is an important place for scientists to study resident communities in ancient agriculture. The village gate, banyan, well, communal house are important factors in classifying Duong Lam ancient village."

Take a walk to visit market around ancient village. Pay a visit to the Temple of King Phung Hung and King Ngo Quyen. Have lunch at local restaurant.

The sightseeing continues to visit Mong Phu temple in Mong Phu hamlet. Then take a trip to explore special ancient village gate there. The original village entrance gate remains intact, dedicated to national heroes. Continue to visit the ancient houses and have some talks with the locals in there. Return transfer to Hanoi. End of services.
