At 8:00 – 8:30AM, pick up at your hotel in Hanoi. Visit the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum* and Museum to explore the architectural and historical aspects of Uncle Ho's final resting-place. Next door there is Ho Chi Minh's house on stilts and the One Pillar Pagoda (Mot Cot) which was founded by King Ly Thai To in 1049. According to legend, the pagoda's shape was inspired by the lotus flower and this structure has become an important symbol for the people of Hanoi. Continue to the Buddhist Tran Quoc Pagoda on the West Lake (One of the oldest pagoda in Vietnam). Then visit Bat Trang pottery village (only on Monday, Wednesday & Friday). Lunch at the local restaurant.

After lunch, visit the Ethnology Museum (on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday & Sunday), the Temple of Literature (Quoc Tu Giam) which is Vietnam's first university, constructed in 1070. You will enjoy its well-preserved architecture and a relaxing walk in its gardens. Then continue to the wonderful Hoan Kiem Lake and walk across the famous red wooden bridge to visit the Ngoc Son Temple set on a tiny island. For the last part of the tour



explore Hanoi's Old Quarter, also called the "36 streets" referring to the different categories of products which used to be sold in each street. The tour ends around 15:30 – 16:00, drop off at your hotel.

You can also choose to extend the tour by attending a water puppet show (\$5), which is a tradition from the 11th century, born in the villages of the Red River Delta region of northern Vietnam.

*The Mausoleum opens only in the morning, on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday. It closes annually in September – December for restoration.

Upon arrival, embark for a 4-h boat trip on a traditional Vietnamese junk and cruise through the huge limestone rocks on the Bay's emerald water.

After lunch, visit one of the most beautiful caves of the Bay called Thien Cung Cave. The tiny islands are dotted with innumerable beaches and caves that make an excellent backdrop for swimming or just lazing about on the boat deck. You can also choose our kayaking option.

At the end of the afternoon the boat takes you back to the harbor where your minibus will be waiting for you to take you back to Hanoi (arrival around 20:30).

At 8:00 – 8:30AM, pick up at your hotel in Hanoi and departure to Hoa Lu (2.5-h drive). See the picturesque countryside on the way.

Upon arrival at Hoa Lu, visit the historic capital of Vietnam and the famous ancient temples of Le and the Dinh Dynasties, the two heroes who built this citadel in the 10th century. Then our bus will transfer you from Hoa Lu to Tam Coc for lunch around 12:30.

After lunch, embark for a boat trip to visit Tam Coc and see the beauty of the geological formations as you pass along their base and row into one of the many caves carved through the limestone.

Then, cycle for an hour on quiet roads through villages, rice fields, rivers and rocky outcrops in Tam Coc - Bich Dong (around 5 km).

Dive back to Hanoi and drop off at your hotel around 18:00.

DESCRIPTION

The Trang An Tourism Complex in the northern province of Ninh Binh was officially included in the world heritage list on June 23 by the UNESCO's World Heritage Committee. The eco tourist attraction located in the East of Ninh Binh, with area of 2000 ha, is divided into 5 function parts: special protection area (Hoa Lu Ancient Capital), the centre, caves area, service and travel area, spirit area Bai Dinh Pagoda. It includes 47 historical vestiges with many mysterious things, with Limestone Mountains, valleys and underground river systems. With hundreds of statues, Bai Dinh (Gia Vien, Ninh Binh) is considered one of the biggest pagodas and has the most statues in Vietnam. Bai Dinh Trang Anh tour in Ninh Binh is very popular in festival after Luna New Year holiday!

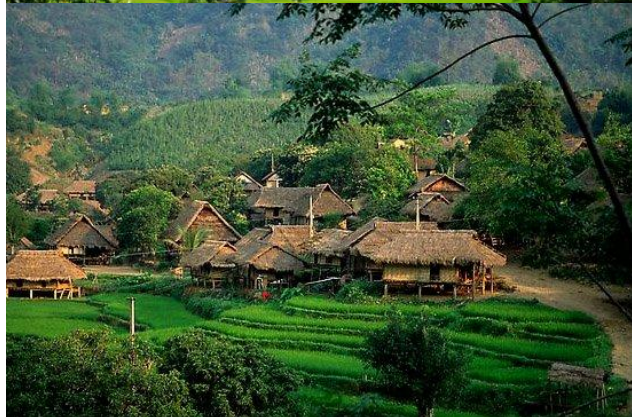
